



Frequently Asked Questions

When do classes begin at Zoe University?

Zoe University is a **Distance Learning** University and has open enrollment. Enrollment for **Distance Learning** can take place any day of the week and classes can begin immediately. All required course materials are sent directly to the student so they can begin their studies on the same day their courses are received in the mail.

What happens with the graded homework?

Upon completion of all homework by the student, including written papers and completing the study guide, all materials that were sent to the student is then returned to Zoe University by them. The student should include a self-addressed and stamped envelope that is no smaller than 10 inches by 13 inches. Zoe University will grade the student's home work and then return it to them by mail.

How Can I take classes at Zoe University?

Whether you live in Jacksonville or any other part of the world all you have to do is download an application and fill it out, send the application along with the registration fee of \$35.00 and the service fee of \$100.00 along with the cost of the course (if you are transferring in credits from another college, there is a transcript evaluation and recording fee of \$25.00). The cost of each course is dependent upon whether you are just beginning your studies (\$90 per credit hour) or you are at the Masters level (\$100 per credit hour), Specialist level (\$110 per credit hour) or the Doctoral level (\$120 per credit hour).

How do I pay for classes while attending Zoe University?

Zoe University accepts checks, money orders and the major credit cards of Visa, Discover, MasterCard and American Express. Zoe University will also finance a student so they only pay for each course as they are studying it. The non-refundable registration fee of \$35.00 and the service fee of \$100.00 must be paid at the beginning. Then each course can be paid for until all required courses have been completed. No degree or transcript will be given until all fees are currently paid.

When was Zoe University founded?

Zoe University was founded by Dr. Judy Fiorentino in Jacksonville, Florida on May 14, 1981.

Is Zoe University accredited?

Zoe University was accredited on March 21, 1988. It is accredited with The Accrediting Commission International. ACI is the world's largest non-governmental accrediting agency.

What type of organization is Zoe University?

It is a not for profit section 501 (C) (3) corporation that has no ownership and is controlled by the Board of Trustees.

Can I study abroad through Zoe University?

Yes, you can! Students have attended Zoe University through the Distance Learning program from more than 48 countries. Internships for college credit are available all over the world in the ministries of friends of Zoe University. These locations include England, Germany, Holland, Indonesia, Israel, Mexico, Philippines and Zimbabwe.

Are there special arrangements made for the Handicapped Student?

Persons with special disabilities may receive their education from Zoe University at no cost. After they contact the office at Zoe University they will be sent a packet of information. Once they have received the packet they may contact their case worker and they in turn will make the arrangements for their education through Zoe University to be paid.

What degrees does Zoe University offer?

Zoe University offers a full suite of degrees in the fields of Theology and Christian Counseling. Zoe University offers Associates, Bachelors, Masters, Specialists and Doctorates in these specialties.

How long does it take to complete a course?

Each course is designed to be completed within a thirty (30) day period.

Is it possible to go at a faster pace than one course a month?

Yes. An accelerated program of study is available to satisfy the needs of those students desiring to move at a faster rate. The nature of the program imparts the maximum amount of knowledge and experience with a minimum amount of inconvenience which is determined by the learning pace of each individual students.
